A little bit of his story. He was born in San Diego and raised in Encinitas. He had a good childhood, great Christian parents and grew up going to church. He got diagnosed with ADHD and got put on Ritalin and Aderall – but graduated from high school with a 4.0 GPA. When his Grandmother passed away he inherited a large amount of money. With that, he lived at a resort, bought and totalled multiple cars, got the full Apple package, went to a few years of college but started abusing the Aderall again. He had been In a relationship for 5 years, but she broke it off as she saw him abusing Percocet and Xanax, then moving on to heroin. He thought he

could use prescription meds and drugs and somehow act sober. He ended up moving in with his dad who told him, “You’re using and you are going to be homeless July 1, so you better find a place to go.” He came to Joshua House in June of 2017. He graduated from the program



in June of 2018. He met Helen and I had the privilege of doing their wedding November 7th, 2020. Their son Jack was

born February 25, 2022 and baby Olivia joined their family in July of this year. He is now Executive Director at Asana Recovery (see his bio below). As we look at all that God has done in Jonathan’s life we can’t help but be reminded of what God says in Jeremiah 32:27 “Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh; is anything too difficult for Me?” *When we look at Jonathan’s life the answer is definitely “NO”.*
